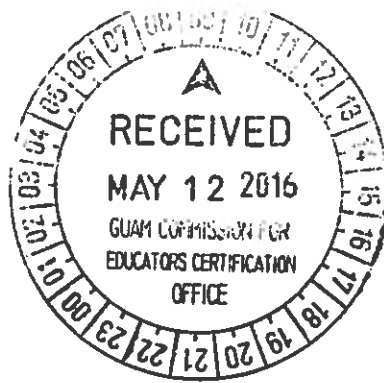

Hope this letter finds you well. I write this letter of request to plead my case before the board in hope to be granted the chance adapt the Middle School Science Praxis (5440) in lieu of the General Science Praxis (5435) for at least the middle school level teacher certification. I have completed the teacher certification program in fall of 2010 and obtained my Masters of Arts in Teaching degree in Spring of 2011 at the University of Guam and was given an opportunity to teach 8th grade Science at F.B. Leon Guerrero Middle School from 2009-2014 under the temporary teaching certificate. Despite of my limited term status, FBLG has continued to welcome me back every school year from 2009-2014 as an 8th grade Science Teacher and as a Guidance Counselor from 2014-present.

Unfortunately, the only barrier that has prevented me from continuing and to be fully certified in the teaching profession is passing Praxis II content test, General Science. I have taken the test five times in the course of at least 5 years but sadly to say all of which with no success with my highest attained score of 138 (passing score is 150). Science is one of the top content areas that the Guam Department of Education is in dire need of teachers. I am aware that my educational background in Science is limited, but I truly believe that my knowledge could be enough for at least the middle school Science. My teaching degree and experience has prepared me well enough, equipped with effective classroom management, lesson plans, teaching strategies such as Classroom Instruction that Works (CITW) and SIOP Model, as well as the Common Core Standards and many more.

I humbly request for your consideration regarding this matter. Thank you for taking the time to hear my request.

Reference: Amendment of Ethics/Discipline Law

Greetings:

In furtherance of the recent meeting with the Commission Chairperson and Executive Director, The GFT herewith submits to the Commission as a whole the amendment that GFT would like the Commission to concur in; so as to make more fair and reasonable the Commission's initial actions once a matter that may call for investigation and discipline is brought to the Commission's attention.

The requested amendment only applies to Classified Government of Guam Educators. What is requested as an amendment is that once a matter is brought to the Commission, but it is also the subject of an Adverse Action, that the Commission Red-Flag the file, but not initiate investigatory or prosecutorial action until the Adverse Action process has been completed through the Guam Civil Service Commission. If no Adverse Action is undertaken, then certainly the Commission would be free to act.

The concern is that the Public Education/Classified Service Educator would be facing simultaneously two or perhaps three adversarial proceedings. It is noteworthy that with the new law as to processing time for the Civil Service Commission, the total time involved would only be a few days over six months, the 60 Day Rule and the Four months for Adverse Actions to have Hearings on the Merits commence before the CSC.

The benefit to the Commission, is that it would then have available to it all of the materials developed concerning the Adverse Action Processing, and as well the Transcript from the Civil Service Commission would be available; with its testimony being under oath; with supporting exhibits.

GFT requests the Commission endorse this amendment to the existing law.
